BE IT RESOLVED by the people of the City of Springfield, acting through their duly

elected City Commission, that the Board of County Commissioners of Bay County, Florida,

is urged to adopt a uniform, county-wide ordinance requiring the utilization of a point and

time of sale electronic record keeping and reporting system related to purchases of certain

products containing ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, and/or phenylpropanolamine;

implementing said system with required participation by all retailers of such products

operating within the county, provided that the customer's identifying information to be

reported is already required to be recorded and reported by otherwise applicable law;

making unlawful and imposing penalties upon persons selling or offering to sell such

products without using the system, provided that failure of the system to operate property

through no fault and without the knowledge of the defendant is a complete defense; and

making unlawful and imposing penalties upon persons giving false identification to

purchase such products;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such ordinance shall be effective within the City

of Springfield.
