**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE AMENDED BUDGET OF THE
CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR THE
FISCAL YEAR 2013 – 2014; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield of Bay County, Florida, on December 01, 2014, held a public hearing as required by section 200.065, Florida Statutes;
