CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA RESOLUTION NO. 20-07

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FL AMENDING THE AMOUNT CHARGED FOR THE CONNECTION FEE TO THE CITY'S PUBLIC SEWER SYSTEM; PROVIDING FOR THREE CLASSES OF CONNECTION TO THE PUBLIC SEWER SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS THEREOF WHICH ARE IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Springfield Ordinance No. 354 regulates the use of Public and Private Sewers, the installation and connection to the Public Sewer, providing for sewer service charges and providing penalties for violations thereof; and

WHEREAS, Sewer Ordinance No. 354, Section 10.10 provides that the City may establish a fee for connection to the Public Sewer System by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the cost of materials has increased since the last fee of six hundred dollars (\$600.00) was set in 1987 by Resolution No. 87-3; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 354, Section 4.2 establishes there shall be three (3) classes of permits for sewer connection; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 354, Section 4.3 states all costs and expenses incident to the installation and connection to the City's Public Sewer System shall be borne by the property owner;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. ESTABLISH SEWER CONNECTION FEE BY CLASS.

The City of Springfield hereby establishes a standard service connection for sewer by class as follows:

Residential (standard service) connection: \$ 950.00
Commercial (standard service) connection: \$1,250.00
Industrial (standard service) connection: \$1,850.00

SECTION 2. ADDITIONAL COSTS FOR CONNECTION.

The City of Springfield recognizes that connection to the City's Public Sewer System may require additional costs that exceed a standard service connection and hereby require the property owner to pay all costs for the construction, extension and/or monitoring in addition to the standard service connection fee above.

SECTION 3. AUTHORIZATION AND REPEALER.

This Resolution is adopted pursuant to general home rule powers of the City and the City Charter. All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
