A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD,  
FLORIDA ACCEPTING THE RESULTS OF THE SUPER  
TUESDAY ELECTION IN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD,  
FLORIDA.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the City's Charter and Ordinance No. 527 of the City of Springfield as the same pertain to elections and applicable Florida Statutes, a regular municipal election was scheduled on Tuesday, April 19, 2022, also known as Super Tuesday for the purpose of filling two (2) City Commission seats and the Mayoral seat for four (4) year terms; and

**WHEREAS**, incumbent City Commissioner Jack Kennington qualified for re-election and was the only candidate to qualify for Commission Seat Ward No. 3 (three); and

**WHEREAS**, Cindy Hamre qualified for election and was the only candidate to qualify for Commission Seat Ward No. 4 (four); and

**WHEREAS**, the City's Canvassing Board certified the votes given for the office of Mayor and persons specified in the election as follows:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** the City Commission of the City of Springfield hereby accepts Jack Kennington being unopposed for Commission Seat Ward No. 3 (three), Cindy Hamre being unopposed for Commission Seat Ward No. 4 (four), and Ralph Hammond as the winner by majority vote for the Mayoral seat declaring them to be elected for a four (4) year term commencing with the administering of the Oath of Office as attached hereto and acceptance thereof by each candidate.
