

RESOLUTION NO. 23-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FINAL LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, BAY COUNTY, FLORIDA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 – 2024; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, sets out the method of fixing millage by the governing body of a taxing authority such as the City of Springfield of Bay County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Section 200.065(2)(d), Florida Statutes, requires the City Commission of the City of Springfield, Florida, to compute the millage rate to be levied in relation to the “rolled-back rate” computed pursuant to Section 200.065(1), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Final Millage rate is more than the Current Year Aggregate Rolled-back rate of 4.2606; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within the City of Springfield, Bay County, has been certified by the Bay County Property Appraiser to the City of Springfield as \$347,905,879.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Springfield in Bay County, Florida, that:

1. Pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the City Commission for the City of Springfield sets the final millage rate as 4.8650 mills.
2. The FY 2023-2024 final operating millage rate for the City of Springfield is more than the rolled-back rate of 4.2606 mills by 0.6044 mills and is a 14.19% increase from the rolled-back rate.
3. This Resolution shall be in force and take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption by the City Commission.
